Hidden in a grove of trees not far from downtown Savannah and its ports, sits Woodville Tompkins. As one of the first specialty high schools in Chatham county, Woodville Tompkins has built a reputation of excellence where hundreds of students now apply to attend. With a wide variety of CTAE, academic, and dual enrollment options, Woodville Tompkins meets not only the needs of our students, but provides them opportunities to walk out of high school with a diploma with opportunities for industry recognized certifications and careers.

Woodville Tompkins has partnered with over 100 businesses and civic organizations to help students be gainfully employed post high school. CTAE programs have set up practicums and apprenticeships, field trips, and mini conferences with our business partners. This hands-on approach has helped students attain certification in areas such as nursing, Microsoft Office products, Hospitality, Programming, and OSHA. Additionally, many graduates return as alumni to mentor students struggling in school to stay focused, set, and accomplish goals.

CTAE is not limited to business and financial based courses at Woodville Tompkins. Students are encouraged to complete a business or financial literacy pathway in addition to any of the fifteen other pathways provided. Students have the choice to enter service based programs such as cosmetology, health care, or early childhood development. Automotive, manufacturing and welding is available for those whose careers might involve working at the local port or manufacturing businesses. For students who want to fly, our aviation program gets them in the air, with actual logged hours in the cockpit. Most students leave Woodville Tompkins with at least one pathway completed if not three.

The classroom is not the only place where learning takes place. The Work Based Learning course helps students earn coveted internships at places like Gulf Stream, JCB, and other high paying corporations who call Savannah home. While in these internships, students learn valuable work skills, communication skills, and when successfully completed, a smooth transition into a career that is satisfying. Offered to juniors and seniors, Work Based Learning has become an integral part of the CTAE program.

Diversity is celebrated and planned for at Woodville Tompkins. Every year, we celebrate the diversity that is our school and world community through an International Festival. Started as a way to celebrate the various heritages of our students, our International Festival is now attended by and has participants from neighboring districts, other states, and community groups dedicated to Heritage Preservation. Students are encouraged to learn about and appreciate what makes us unique and the same through language study. Level III and AP World Language courses are available.
